



Quality Control Technician

Each Quality Control Technician will be responsible for monitoring, testing, and reporting on many different aspects of our product manufacturing process. These responsibilities include raw material inspections, finished goods inspections, production activities, safety checks, and more.

Each Quality Control Technician will work closely with plant workers, Shift Supervisors, and the Plant Manager. We're seeking two hard-working team players that can use their existing manufacturing and quality control skills and experience to help us achieve the best productivity, quality, and safety available to our company, its customers, and our employees.

Job Responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain production inspection checklists and reports.
- Ensure compliance to company standards and specifications, federal and state laws.
- Maintain calibration of quality control equipment.
- Perform inspections across all stages of production.
- Prepare and maintain test data for review.
- Participate in the analysis of data and reports, noting relevant deviations from standards.
- Identify areas for improvement and participate in the implementation of new methods.
- Communicate quality or compliance concerns to Shift Supervisors and Plant Management.
- On an as needed basis and for training purposes, participate in the manufacturing process in a "utility player" capacity, able to pitch in where needed and perform all steps in the production process.
- Liaise and coordinate with Shift Supervisors and Plant Management to identify issues concerning production planning and resource/skill allocation to ensure delivery of products to schedule within all relevant quality specifications.
- Communicate often and clearly with production staff to keep a focus on quality, cost and delivery, and gathering ideas for production improvement.
- Assist Plant Manager in the conducting of employee appraisals.
- Provide hands-on training to current and new employees.

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- Ensure safe working practices are maintained and adhered to.
- Assist in and support the implementation of engineering changes, production trials, model changes, and prototype builds.
- Support, comply, and ensure complicity with Health & Safety regulations, the Company Handbook, Quality and Environmental standards, and all other Company policies and procedures.
- Identify and report all incident, accident and non-conformity issues to Plant Management.

Compensation:

This is a full-time position offering a starting hourly pay of \$14 per hour or more. Benefits may be provided after the employee completes 90 days of satisfactory work in this position.

Work Schedule:

Work days and hours may be flexible depending on shift scheduling. We currently operate first and third shifts Monday through Friday.
